GREETINGS FROM YOUR PRESIDENT

Summer is in full swing on Upper Hay Lake!

The UHLA held its annual meeting on June 13, 2024, at the Pequot Lakes American Legion for a burger night, association updates, and speaker, Jarret Drileck from the Crow Wing SWCD. The July 5th Independence Day parade was a success with favorable weather and about 30 watercraft circling the lake. On another note, the board is concerned about the significant drop in paid members for 2024. We have sent out an email with a registration form as a membership appeal. As members, please consider talking to your neighbors about joining the organization.

First and foremost, we want all property owners to be members so that we can effectively communicate with everyone concerning matters that affect all of us. In addition, we want to hear from folks like you who have ideas for other projects. The more members we have, the more ideas we can consider.

The Lake Association conducts projects that benefit all lake property owners. We are permitted to control vegetation near our docks and swimming areas in a 40-ft. wide by 150-ft. out from shore area for nuisance vegetation.

Recently, I emailed Jarret Drileck at the Crow Wing SWCD about the dramatic increase in algae globules near the south shoreline. I inquired about what they were, and what, if anything, we could do about them.

He has not responded yet. We will need to work together to control vegetation growth in our lake. There is also interest in clearing vegetation to navigate the outlet into Lower Hay Lake. This will take a team of volunteers to contact the DNR and the Army Corps of Engineers to get permission and come up with a plan. Several years ago, UHLA was granted permission, but it was rescinded shortly thereafter. Perhaps it is time to investigate possible clearing of the waterway again. Again, please recruit your neighbors to become UHLA members. Together we can get important projects done!
